

SHAMBALA 60':

Shambala is a well maintained vessel with 3412 Caterpillar Turbo engines allowing for a top speed of 32 knots. The entire interior is finished in cherry wood. The salon is comfortable with an "L" shaped Italian leather seating arrangement, dinette for six, complete galley with trash compactor, two refrigerators, two freezers, Direct T.V that functions even whilst at sea, both on the bridge and down below, Sirius Radio, DVD, VHS, CD player, I Pod plug in so you can bring your favorite tunes. The master stateroom has a queen size bed, with bathroom en suite with a shower/tub and Direct TV. The VIP guest stateroom has a double bed, own bathroom and T.V with VCR. The third stateroom can be used for guests or as crews quarters, own bathroom with shower; washer and dryer also aboard. A large comfy bow cushion is ideal for sunbathing, a big plus when the ladies come along.

Two bait tanks are located in the cockpit, plus another on the bow of the boat for a capacity of 250 baits, when needed, nine tuna tubes make sure you never run out of large bait when necessary. The cockpit has an icemaker for keeping your fish cool in the hold, plus a tackle center with a large selection of lures. Two GPS, side scanning sonar, water maker, two generators, tuna tower. The bridge is large with ample, shaded seating for guests to spend time up top. Fishing equipment ranges from spinning gear for light tackle to 100 lb tackle and Penn Internationals, plus kites and a downrigger. What is so special about this vessel is the captain. T.J Dobson who is originally from Oklahoma but moved to Cabo when he was a teenager and has been fishing every since.

Now a Mexican citizen he still has a charming Midwestern drawl and is highly esteemed as one of the best fisherman in Cabo by both his American and Mexican counterparts, which is saying a lot. T.J has fished from Hawaii to Panama and has placed ten times in tournaments both in Mexico and Hawaii. His largest marlin to date is a 862 lb blue caught in Kona, his largest tuna 318 lbs, he also has a 420 lb swordfish and two wahoo over 100 lbs. T.J was the winning captain in the 2008 Tuna Tournament. T.J loves to fish pitch baits and his record number of striped marlin in one day is 60, at the Finger Banks. T.J is easy going and pleasant to be around.

- **EL GALLO 60'**

This beautiful yacht/sport fisher was built in 2003 and is in pristine condition. Possibly the finest sportfisher in the Cabo Marina. From the moment you step aboard, there is no doubt that this is a serious fishing vessel. Starting with the extra wide cockpit, which contains a professional, hydraulic-swivel fighting chair, two live bait wells and complete tackle center, this vessel has everything needed to make your day a success. The powerful 1480 Turbo engines have a top speed of over 38 knots, whilst the boat design ensures a smooth, stable ride. The salon is spacious with sofas in beige leather the dinette provides ample seating in ostrich skin, complemented with a 48" flat screen TV.

The galley is complete with refrigerators, freezers, microwave, range, icemaker and trash compactor. Sound system throughout as well as air-conditioning, XM satellite radio and full safety gear. The master stateroom has a queen size bed with T.V and bathroom en suite; the guest stateroom has one double and one single bed with bathroom en suite also. The third stateroom has two bunks with own full bathroom, washer and dryer. The bridge is decked out in state of the art electronics including GPS, radar, depth sounder, autopilot and infrared "Red Eye" as well as large reflectors for nighttime.

With large capacity fuel tanks allowing for extended trips. Fishing tackle is by Shimano, ranging from 25 to 130 lbs. Captain "Nayo" (Genaro) Winkler is a local legend; Nayo has over 29 years experience fishing Cabo including two first places in the famous Bisbee tournament in 1985 and 2003. He has also claimed two seconds in this same event in 1993 and 2001. He was also the top captain in the world for releasing striped marlin in 1997. Nayo is a native of Cabo San Lucas, speaks good English. He is unassuming, friendly and a pleasure to spend the day with.

- **MICK 80':**

Mick was built in 2007 and is a fantastic yacht for spending a day on the water. The design and layout is very thoughtful, with large spaces for spending time with your group. The salon is paneled with Burmese teak and the plush carpet is a delight to walk on. The salon offers comfortable seating whilst you relax or watch a game on the pop up flat screen T.V, the salon flows into the galley, which has a sit up bar where you can watch the staff prepare a tasty snack or meal. The galley is has granite countertops and a practical layout which includes, microwave, convection oven, stove, dual dishwashers, trash compactor, three refrigerators and a freezer.

The open floor plan extends from the galley to the one of the two captain's stations, which also has a dinette with seating for six. Closed circuit T.V allows you to see what is going on outside the yacht, an important safety feature, especially with children aboard. The master stateroom has a king size bed with designer bedding, luxuriously cozy; satellite T.V, full bathroom finished in red granite. The second cabin has twin beds and is cheerfully decorated, TV and DVD plus bathroom "en suite". The VIP cabin has a queen size bed and large bathroom with plenty of light, full shower and many decorative touches. Steps lead from the salon to the upper deck which is large and open. The captain usually operates the boat from this fly bridge area, where there is an L shaped dinette, which is shaded, as well as lounge chairs for sunbathing.

Stairs leading down from the oversize fly bridge bring you to the California deck, set up with a table and seating for four, shaded but overlooking the fishing area. There is a built in barbecue if you want to try your fish really fresh. Mick has a dive compressor as well as ice maker, water maker, air conditioning throughout, I Pod plug in, DVD, satellite T.V, radar, sonar, GPS and Nav Net. What makes the Mick really special is her crew; Jim and Carolyn Lilly are experienced seamen, with Jim holding a 100 ton license, he is familiar with every aspect of his vessel and the seas. Spending many years as a long range captain, gave him incredible fishing skills and made him resourceful in resolving any problem at sea.

You know you are in capable and safe hands with Jim Lilly. Jim's most endearing characteristic is his wonderful personality, you cannot find a more likeable or well-mannered person. He will make you laugh with his positive outlook on nearly every situation. Carolyn is Jim's wife of 26 years and they work together effortlessly. Carolyn welcomes you aboard in her own warm manner and immediately puts you at ease and attends to your every need, she also holds her own as an accomplished chef. The galley is well designed with all amenities for preparing fabulous meals.

The dramatic master stateroom is spacious, with sitting area, desk, tasteful accents; this beautifully designed stateroom features an en suite on a separate level including a large Jacuzzi. The V.I.P. guest stateroom is welcoming with a queen bed, en suite and large closet. Two other staterooms have twin beds, plus a Murphy bed in each for extra guests, each have their own full en suites. The captain’s station is on the mezzanine floor and has an ample seating area done out in black leather. The array of instruments is impressive, including sonar, radar, GPS, Nav. Net, Satellite phone, security cameras and other features. The upper deck is where most guests spend their time, this partially shaded area gives the option of sun or shade. In the shaded area there are two large “L” shaped sitting areas with tables that can accommodate up to twelve guests, plus a bar with comfy stools.

In the sunny part of this deck is a Jacuzzi and a large deck cushion for sunbathing. There is an additional captain’s station on the upper deck. On the bow of the boat there is another large sun bed. Scorpio has a large swim platform making it easy to get in and out of the water, or to get set-up on her wave runner. Full snorkeling gear plus a dinghy. Washer & Dryer aboard. Separate crew quarters. Three to five crew members. First aid equipment including on board defibrillator. Captain Ted Drummond has spent his life at sea and is very professional, coming from a commercial tuna fishing background, he has been aboard luxury yachts for the past six years. He has boated as far afield as Papau, New Guinea and is a San Diego native. The photos say it all.
